Voter Registration Deadlines for New Voters for York County, SC

In order to vote in an upcoming election, residents must register to vote 30 days prior to any election. Polling Locations and Precincts are open from 7:00am until 7:00pm on Election Dates.

SC Voters have three methods of voting in any election:

- Absentee (BY- MAIL ONLY) Last day to request an absentee by mail ballot is 5pm on the 11th day before the election.
- <u>Early Voting</u> Begins two weeks prior to Election Day at Early Voting Locations
- Election Day From 7am to 7pm at your registered polling location.
