

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA REPUBLICAN PARTY IN
SUPPORT OF DESIGNATING SOUTH CAROLINA A
"BILL OF RIGHTS SANCTUARY STATE"

WHEREAS, in recent years the federal government has issued a series of statutes, regulations, Executive Orders, and similar diktats (collectively "Orders") which infringe upon the rights guaranteed to the people, and the powers reserved to the states, under the United States Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the pace and intrusiveness of such Orders has been accelerating since Joseph Biden was sworn in as President; and

WHEREAS, many of such Orders, either now issued or under active consideration, would severely infringe upon the rights guaranteed by the 1st, 2nd, 4th, and 10th Amendments; and

WHEREAS, it is the function of the state of South Carolina, acting through its elected representatives serving in the General Assembly, to act as a bulwark against unwarranted and unconstitutional federal intrusions;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the South Carolina Republican Party calls upon the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina to officially declare South Carolina a "Bill of Rights Sanctuary State", and to enact legislation which bars every official or entity of the State, including its political subdivisions, from assisting in the enforcement of any Order deemed to be unconstitutional.
